- To ensure the sensitivity of the contents and to follow BNI media values and media ethic
- To collaborate with the team to come up with fresh and creative ideas, keeping the audience in mind
- Ability to manage multiple tasks and consistently meet deadlines
- To submit a monthly progress report
- To Perform the assignments based on the needs of the BNI management teams
